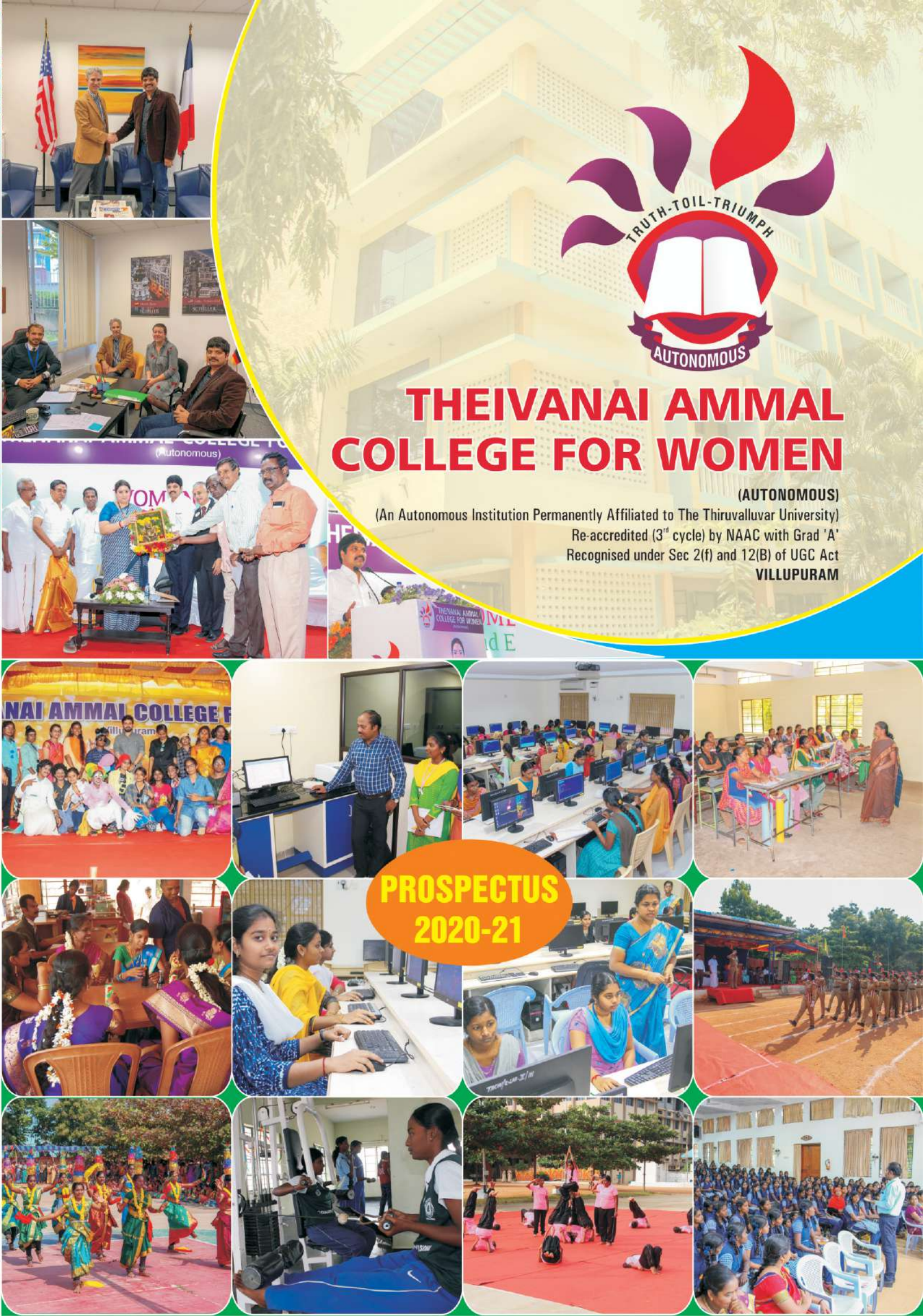

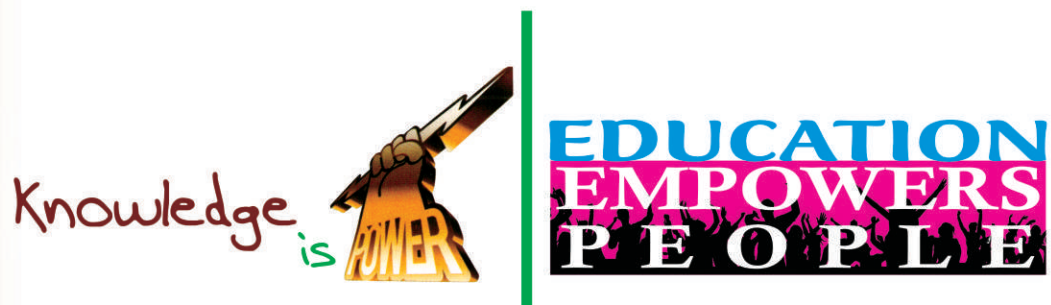

## ELIGIBILITY NORMS

### UG

Candidate seeking admission to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree must have passed higher secondary examination (+2) conducted by the Government of Tamilnadu or an examination accepted as equivalent.

The Upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July of the year of admission. However a relaxation upto 3 years for the physically challenged and 3 years for women candidates is permitted.

### PG

For admission to PG, the candidate must have passed a 3 year Degree course (under 10+2+3 pattern). For courses the qualifying examination marks in part III (major, allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

### M.Phil.

Candidates seeking admission to research programmes must have completed their relevant Post Graduate Degree with minimum 55% of marks and 5% relaxation to SC/ST Candidate.

### Ph.D.

The candidate should have obtained Masters Degree with minimum 55% of marks and 5% relaxation to SC/ST candidate in their relevant master degree and a pass in common entrance test conducted by Thiruvalluvar University.

Cost of application form is Rs. 350/-

## Research & Development cell

Research & Development cell has been contributed with a full time coordinator to promote Research activities in the college. The cell conducts training programmes in research for PG students and M.Phil scholars, inviting experts from reputed institutes. The cell coordinated the conduct of discipline wise National Seminars in the college on recent trends. Faculty & students participation in off campus research activities is motivated by the cell. - Faculty participated and presented more than ten papers in International conferences conducted off campus. Eleven Papers were published in books with ISBN/ISSN. Thirteen Papers were published in UGC care listed Journals in the year 2019-2020. A few Faculty are also reviewers for Elsevier and Scopus indexed Journals.
- Students from all the departments attended, participated and presented papers in Conferences, seminars and workshops conducted by other Colleges and 34 such activities have been registered for the year 2019-2020.
- There are 24 approved Guides for M.Phil from all the Departments and at present ten students have registered for Ph.D and pursuing research in the approved Courses.

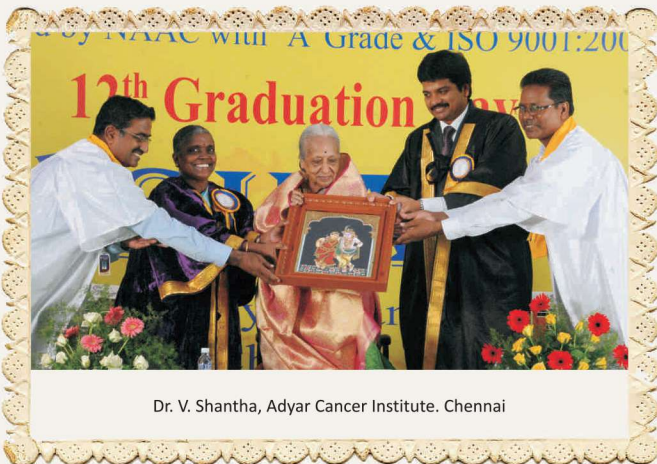
