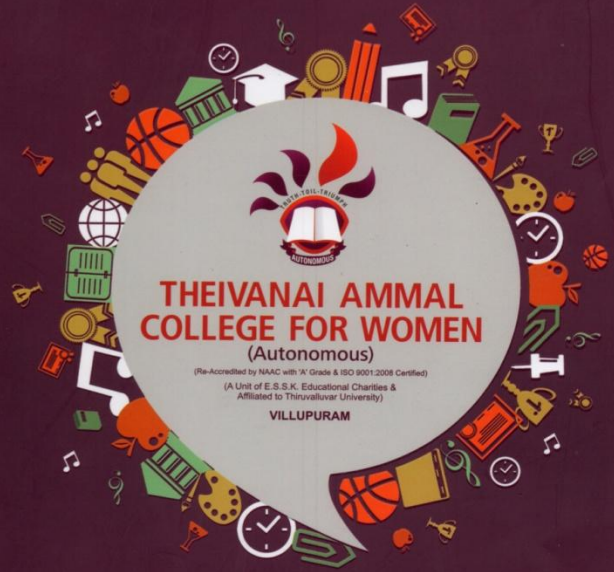

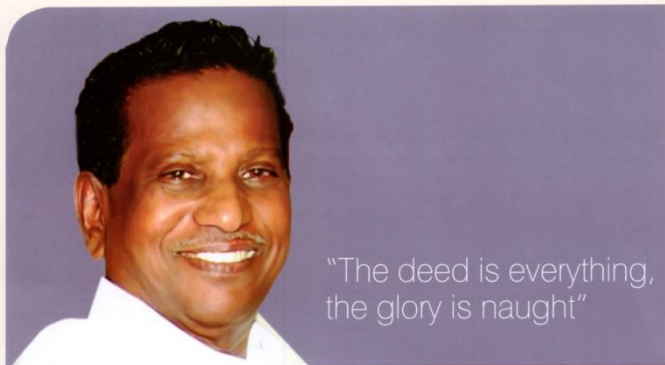

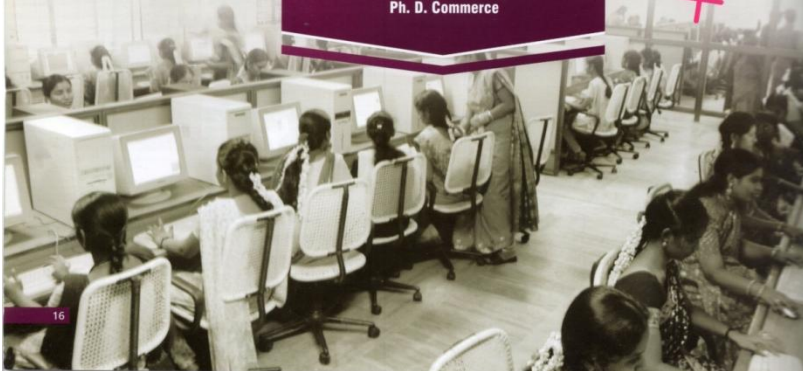

** Concession could be availed in any semester only if fee is paid before the due date. If fee is not paid before the due date in any semester, concession could not be availed.

UNDER GRADUATE COURSES

Candidate seeking admission to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree must have passed higher secondary examination (+2) conducted by the Government of Tamilnadu or an examination accepted as equivalent.

The Upper age limit for admission to UG courses is 21 years as on 1st July of the year of admission. However a relaxation upto 3 years for the physically challenged and 3 years for women candidates is permitted.

POST GRADUATE COURSES

For admission to PG, the candidate must have passed a 3 year degree course (under 10+2+3 pattern). For courses, other than MCA the qualifying examination marks in part III (major, allied) alone shall be taken into consideration.

For admission to MCA, AICTE/TANCET Anna University norms will be followed.

The Candidate should have obtained a master's degree with not less than a second class or an equivalent grade.

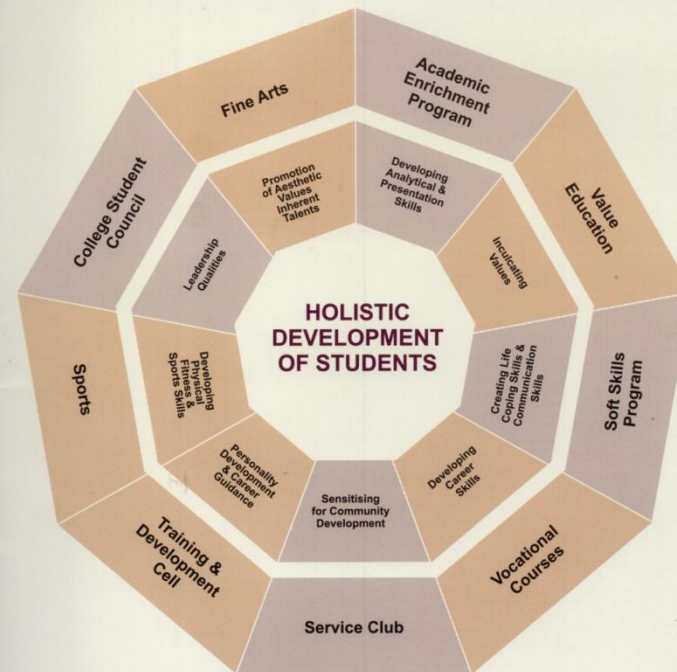

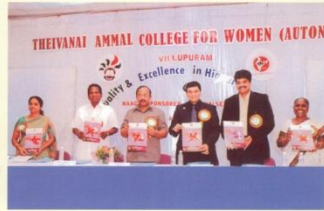
